## A Guide for Making Your Way to Us.



**From I-26:** Take Exit 219B (Morrison Drive, East Bay Street). At the stop sign, turn left and continue for 2.8 miles as road becomes Morrison Drive, then East Bay Street. Turn right on North Market Street. Planters Inn is at the end of the street on your right.

**From U.S. 17, South of Charleston:** Bear right on Lockwood Drive after crossing the Ashley River bridge. Turn left onto Calhoun Street at the first traffic light. Follow Calhoun for 1.4 miles to East Bay Street. Turn right on East Bay to North Market Street. Turn right on North Market. Planters Inn is at the end of the street on your right.

**From U.S. 17, North of Charleston:**  
After crossing the Ravenel Bridge take the Morrison Drive/East Bay Street Exit. Turn left on East Bay to North Market Street (1.8 mls). Turn right on North Market. Planters Inn is at the end of the street on your right.
